

DEAR BELOVED FAMILY AND FRIENDS,

In preparation for a lifetime devoted to one another, we decided to sign the Prenuptial Agreement for Mutual Respect, attempting to do our part to help resolve the Agunah crisis which has devastated the lives of many women in the Orthodox community. A prenuptial agreement allows good people to maintain their goodness and respect for themselves and for one another, no matter what challenges life may bring. This small and uncomplicated step in the marriage process can prevent tragic situations from ever becoming someone's reality.

We encourage you to look into this agreement before getting married, and ask your friends and family member if they have signed it. This document, which is essentially a continuation of the ketubah, protects Jewish women, men and the institution of marriage as a whole.

It is specifically at the beginning of a marriage that this window of opportunity exists through which we may set out together on a path of happiness, founded on deep trust in one another.
